



FROM THE STEWARDSHIP AND FINANCE MINISTRY TEAM, thank you for your dollars and time to support the mission of St. John. We are a blessed congregation that can continue to serve our purpose and mission to share the love of Jesus. However, regardless of our efforts, we need to be good stewards of our resources while carrying out our mission. You may have noticed a decline over time in the Current fund balance. Be aware that this balance may at times reflect negatively. If this happens, the Stewardship and Finance Ministry Team has advised Council and the Treasurer to pay bills from other applicable funds. Along with the Church Council, the Stewardship and Finance Ministry Team will continue to monitor our finances carefully over time. On a monthly basis we have been emailing the fund giving vs expenses charts so the congregation is kept apprised of our financial status. Please take the time to review the charts and prayerfully discern how you might have some impact going forward. If you are not on this email distribution list, but would like to receive, please let the church office know your email address or pick up a hard copy of the charts for your review. DEAR FRIENDS IN CHRIST, I am excited to announce that I have accepted a call as full-time Synodically Authorized Minister serving at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Jenera, Ohio. Jenera is an hour and ten minutes (67 miles Northwest) from our home. My call with St. Paul begins August first. The congregation is renovating the parsonage and the renovations include making it handicapped accessible. Dick and I have gone through the house and are confident it will meet our needs. The renovation is to be completed by October. In October we will be moving into the parsonage, but until then we will commute for Sundays and times when it is necessary to be present in person. CARDINGTON FOOD PANTRY UPDATE.....Due to the current state of the economy, Cardington Community Food Pantry is experiencing difficulties getting our pantry families cans of fruits and vegetables from Mid-Ohio Food Cooperative. Please consider purchasing an extra can(s) of fruit or vegetables and donating to the food pantry when you do your own grocery shopping. **For August we will be collecting canned carrots.** The results of the Food Pantry in July is: Total of Household Served/563; Total Number of Individuals in Households/1,754; Total of New Households in July/82; Total Number of New Individuals in Households/249; total Meals Served/22,485. These numbers continue to rise and we expect the coming months to do the same. Food is getting harder to obtain from Mid-Ohio Food Cooperative as they are having the same issues. President of MOF is working with Governor Mike DeWine to obtain \$335 million dollars for the Central Ohio 700 food pantries. Our continued thanks to all of you and your congregations for your love, prayers and monetary support to help our community. God is Good!
